



2012 NABITY SCHOLARSHIP

Attention PIIAC Young Agent agency members! You may be eligible to receive scholarship assistance to attend the **2012 IIABA National Legislative Conference and Convention April 25-27 in Washington, D.C.**

PIIAC's Nability Fund annually sponsors a limited number of full to partial scholarships for members who qualify. Any insurance professional employed by a PIIAC member agency who is age 40 or younger, or who has been in the insurance industry for less than five years is eligible to apply. And, applying for a Nability Scholarship is easy! Simply complete the application form, and submit it to PIIAC along with a short essay on how attendance at this association-sponsored event will contribute to the betterment of your career and help your employer.

The deadline to apply for a scholarship is February 3, 2012. Selection of scholarship recipients is based on eligibility and essay content. Scholarship recipients will be notified by February 10, 2012. Multiple scholarships may be awarded.

- Applicant must be employed by a member agency in good standing with the Professional Independent Insurance Agents of Colorado, Inc.
- Applicant is a first-time attendee to the event and ***not*** a prior Nabity Scholarship recipient.
- Applicant must be 40 years of age or younger or a licensed insurance producer in the industry for less than 5 years.
- Applicant agrees to attend all scheduled events associated with the scholarship and agrees to submit a written summary about his/her experience for publication in the ***Colorado Insurance News***.

Scholarship Rules

Scholarship awards are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash. The total value of a scholarship is up to \$1,000 in eligible reimbursements. Expenses eligible for reimbursement upon receipt of paid receipts are limited exclusively to conference registration for scholarship recipient, lodging for recipient (room and tax) for nights of conference only at the host hotel economy rate and round trip coach, non refundable airfare to the IIABA Conference only. Scholarship recipients are responsible for all additional costs associated with attending the event for which the scholarship is awarded.

Deadline for Nabity Scholarship Application to IIABA Legislative Conference and Convention is February 3, 2012.

No late entries will be accepted. Scholarships are awarded at the sole discretion of the judges. Scholarship recipients will be notified by February 10, 2012.
