Insurance agents and brokers sell Workers' Compensation insurance to their clients, purchase it to cover their employees, and may be eligible for benefits if they get hurt on the job. Some provisions of the New York Workers' Compensation Law have changed in recent years. Other provisions have not changed, but many producers may not be aware of them. - Coverage for injuries resulting from intoxication
- Coverage for injuries caused by worker's willful intent
- Time limits on permanent partial disability benefits
